This year's "Junge Niere" will **start on June 28th at 4:30 pm** with a welcoming session by PD Dr. Stefanie Steiger and Prof. Dr. Miriam Banas in the "**Kleine Aula**" at the main building of the Ludwig-Maximilians-University (LMU) Munich, Geschwister-Scholl-Platz 1 (1. Floor, Room A120). The LMU building is located in the heart of Munich and can be reached from the main train station within 15 minutes by U-Bahn or bus/tram. Afterwards, we welcome **Prof. Dr. med. In his **keynote lecture**, Prof. Kramann will provide an overview of his cutting-edge research on mechanisms associated with chronic kidney disease, tissue fibrosis and cardiovascular complications using state-of-the-art technology. After the lecture, we will go on a **short guided tour** through the historical site of Munich along the Ludwigstrasse passing the Siegestor, Bayerische Staatsbibliothek, Feldherrnhalle, Residenz and Marienplatz before we go for **dinner at the restaurant „Laden“** at 7:30 pm.

There are no registration fees; travel and accommodation costs need to be covered by the participants themselves.

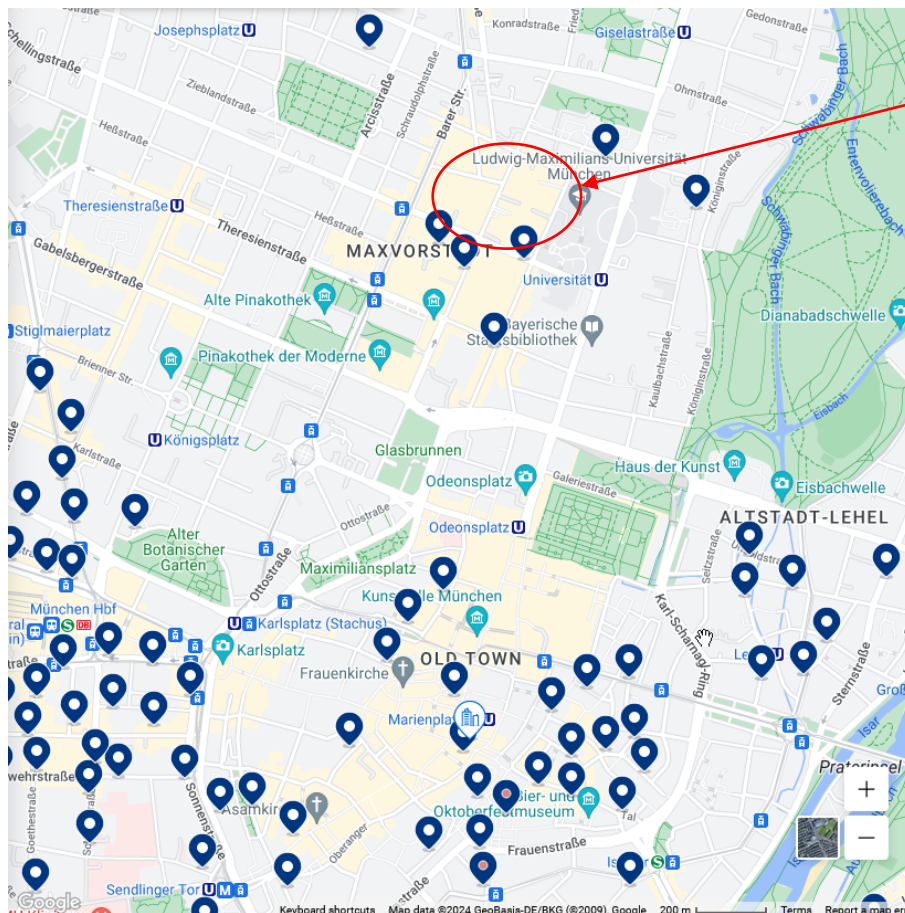
